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

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

How do you define evaluation?



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Evaluation is the systematic assessment of the processes and/or outcomes of a [program, project, service, etc.] with the intent of furthering its development and improvement. The primary purpose of evaluation is to provide timely and constructive information for decision-making.

Public program or service that you want to evaluate





