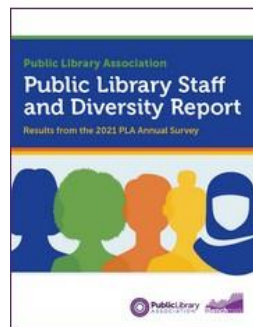
Introducing the Urban Institute's Equity Scholars

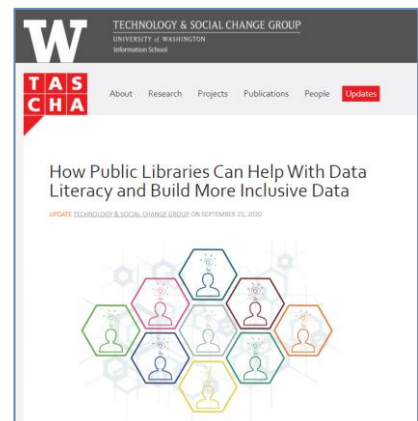
